Admissions Criteria for September 2019 intake



The number of intended admissions is 360.

Children with a statement of special educational needs naming Stantonbury International School will be given preference for admission within the normal admission round at 11+.

If applications for admissions exceed the number of places available the following order of priority will be applied:-

1. 'Looked After' children or children who were previously looked after but immediately after being looked after became subject to an adoption, residence, or special guardianship order
2. Young people living in the listed areas with a sibling* in attendance in Years 8 to 11 at the school at the date of admission and attending one of the named partner schools
3. Children of staff who have been employed at the school for two or more years at the time of which the application for admission to the school is made, and/or children of staff who are recruited to fill a vacant post for which there is a demonstrable skill shortage. It is at the absolute discretion of the Principal to determine when there is a demonstrable skill shortage.
4. Young people living in the listed areas with a sibling* in attendance in Years 8 to 11 at the school at the date of admission
5. Young people living in the listed areas and attending one of the named partner schools
6. Young people living in the listed areas
7. Young people living outside the listed areas with a sibling* in attendance in Years 8 to 11 at the school at the date of admission and attending one of the named partner schools
8. Young people living outside the listed areas with a sibling* in attendance in Years 8 to 11 at the school at the date of admission
9. Young people living outside the listed areas and attending one of the named partner schools
10. Other young people living outside the listed areas

In circumstances where the school admissions number has been exceeded in any of the above categories and there is a need to discriminate within the category, preference will be given to those young people living closest to the school, measured in a straight line to the school main reception using the Local Authority's computerised distance measuring system, with those living nearer to the school receiving the higher priority.

Following the refusal of an application, only one appeal is allowed in the same academic year, unless there has been a significant change in circumstances, e.g. a house move.

In cases where there is one remaining place available and the next child on the waiting list is one of a twin, triplet or other multiple birth groups, all siblings* would be admitted even if this goes above the planned number for the school. *A sibling is a brother or sister, which for admission purposes means brothers and sisters of whole or half blood, or any other child (including an adopted child) who permanently resides at the same address and for whom the parent also has parental responsibility.



Admissions Process at 11+

The Local Authority (LA), as required by the Department for Education, co-ordinates the admissions arrangements for all schools in Milton Keynes. Procedures for applying to Stantonbury International School are explained in the 'Admissions to Secondary Schools in Milton Keynes: Information for Parents' booklet.

In September in the academic year before transfer, information and application forms will be sent by the LA to parents. It is important that parents read this information carefully and meet the deadlines as indicated.

Parents of students residing within the area served by the school will also automatically receive a prospectus from the school with an invitation to visit the school on one of the Prospective Parents' Evenings which take place in late September. A prospectus and invitation will also be distributed to other parents who request one.

A deadline date for the return of application forms will be set by the LA. Applications forms must be returned to the LA as indicated in the 'Information for Parents' booklet. No forms will be accepted at the school. Parents also have the opportunity to apply for a place using the online procedure as outlined in the 'Information for Parents' booklet.

General Admissions

Applications for years other than the year of intake are also made through the Local Authority who organise the co-ordinated scheme for In-Year admissions.
