

Rewards

Here at Stantonbury International School, we reward students based upon our shared values and moral compass.

For example, helping an injured student would demonstrate ‘kindness’; completing an excellent homework might demonstrate ‘independence’; leading a group activity would show ‘responsibility’.

We promote a culture in which we praise students and staff appropriately when we see them demonstrating our shared values. This is done mostly through verbal encouragement. We also reward each other more formally through different levels:

Bronze	Stantonbury Stars, phone calls home, subject-based praise postcards and letters, tutor nomination, notes in planners
Silver	Assembly rewards, senior leader lunches, principal awards, reward badges
Gold	End of term awards, Learning for Life Day reward visits, selected as a Prefect, Amazon voucher

Stantonbury stars will be awarded in line with our school values and moral compass. Students will be awarded a badge and certificate for the following milestones:

Bronze	100 stars
Silver	300 stars
Gold	600 stars
Platinum	1000 stars

Students will also be awarded a badge and certificate for each value when they receive 150 Stantonbury Stars for that specific value (e.g. Integrity, Teamwork, Responsibility). These will be named as a ‘Values Leader Badge.’

Students will have an opportunity to reward each other through a drop box system with each Student Support Leader.

The House Cup

Any Stantonbury Stars awarded to students go towards the total number for their House; Danstead, Grafton, Portway or Saxon.

The House Cup is awarded in the summer term to the House with the highest number of Stantonbury Stars.

House Captains are elected from each year group in each House.
